FullHouse Software currently offers three versions of Investment Property Manager software. Each version has different requirements, but will work under a variety of conditions. This sheet will help you determine which version works best with your hardware, and may inform your future hardware purchases. IPM 2007 can run on any 32-bit PC with a 32-bit version of Windows; it can also run under the “XP Emulation” on Windows 7 (64-bit) Professional or Ultimate, but this is not recommended. IPM Classic and IPM 10 can run on 32-bit or 64-bit PCs with either 32-bit or 64-bit Operating Systems. IPM Classic can run on any PC that will also support Microsoft Office 2000/2003/2005. IPM 10 will run on any PC that will support Microsoft Office 2007. (Microsoft Office is not required to run IPM).

Please note that minimum requirements are for small, simple databases. For larger databases, double the speed and RAM. All versions of IPM will work with databases shared across a network.

For backups, have a writable CD drive, a memory stick, a network drive or a floppy drive available. For installations, install directly from www.fullhousesoftware.com/downloads.aspx. The Users Guide and supportive documentation is installed with all versions of IPM (you may need Adobe’s free PDF Reader to access these documents)
